GBR SHRM, along with Louisiana SHRM, represented our state well at the SHRM Annual Conference & Expo in Las Vegas earlier this month!

SHRM23 Take Aways

A few of our Board Members were able to attend SHRM23 this year. We asked Niki Norton, LSU Assistant Vice President for Human Resource Management, and GBR SHRM Community Relations Chair, what she thought about the conference.

What was your favorite part of the SHRM23 conference?

Mitch Albom's keynote, The Stranger in the Lifeboat: The Power of What You Carry Through Life and Other Important Lessons, was the most inspiring and powerful keynote I'd ever heard. He shared the story of his college professor and mentor, Morrie Schwartz, who's fight with ALS inspired him to "give to live" and the unexpected gift of having Haitian orphan, Chica, come to live with him and his wife during her fight with an incurable brain tumor. Chica helped him see that just because we expect what we asked for to look a certain way and what we get doesn't quite look like how we envisioned, doesn't mean we didn't actually get what we asked for...or what we needed.

What was one topic that really resonated with you?

Beyond the tearjerker above, I'll give you three other major nuggets: 1.) Johnny C Taylor, continued Mitch Albom's sentiments saying that as HR Professionals, our daily work can make a lifelong impact on the people around us. People will remember us, what we did, how we made them feel long afterward and long after we may forget helping them. When HR is done right, we write a chapter in almost everyone's life story. 2.) Al is here and we must embrace it, but Al cannot replicate heart! Artificial Intelligence + Human Intelligence = ROI for organizations. 3.) With labor shortages and facing a demographic cliff, we need to rethink work. This is not a call to lower standards, but to lower barriers. Action is needed now to tear the paper ceiling and focus on skills based hiring that opens the talent pool to greater numbers of qualified candidates and leads to a more inclusive workforce.

How do you plan to put what you learned into action?

With our return from SHRM and working with Community Partner, ThreeSixtyEight on the Assembly Required event last week, we have already started the conversation on skills based hiring in our local community. More work is ahead to discuss policy and foundational elements to bring this to reality for many of our local organizations. I have begun identifying resources and ways in which we may be able to utilize AI in my organization for job descriptions and the screening of candidates in hopes it may streamline processes and help us gain efficiencies in order to spend more time with strategic consultation. And personally, I've taken to heart the words of Mitch Albom and Johnny C. Taylor, to invest more day to day in those around me and strive to play a positive role in other's montage reel of life.
